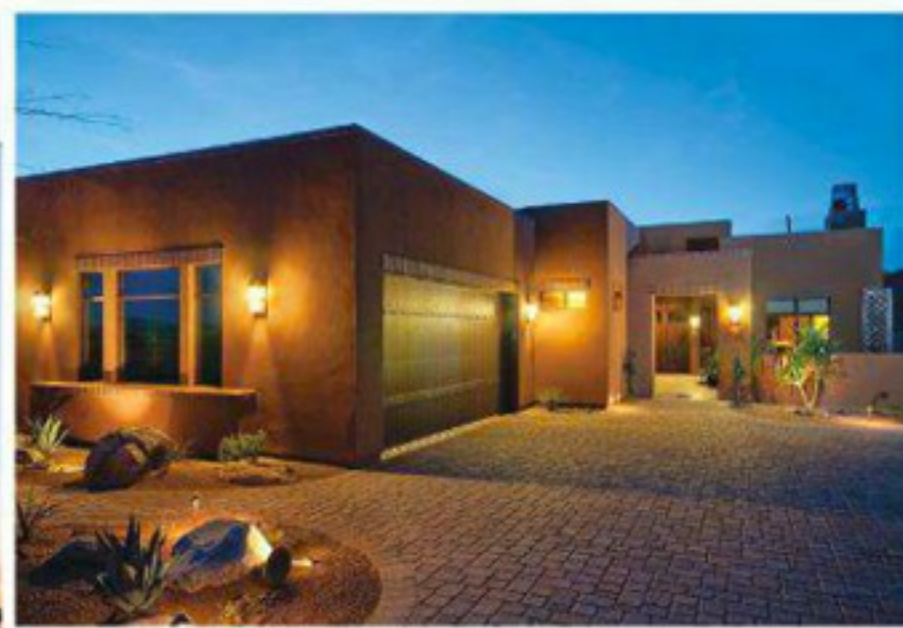

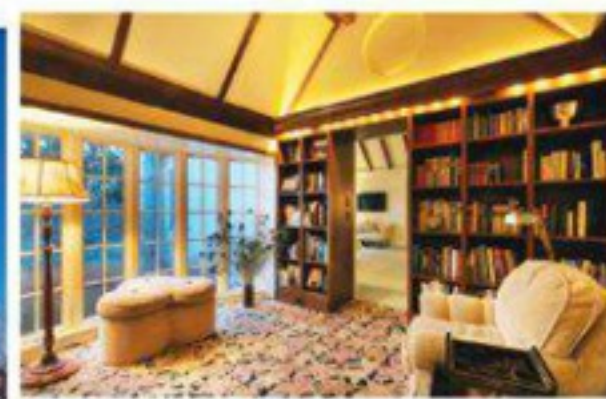
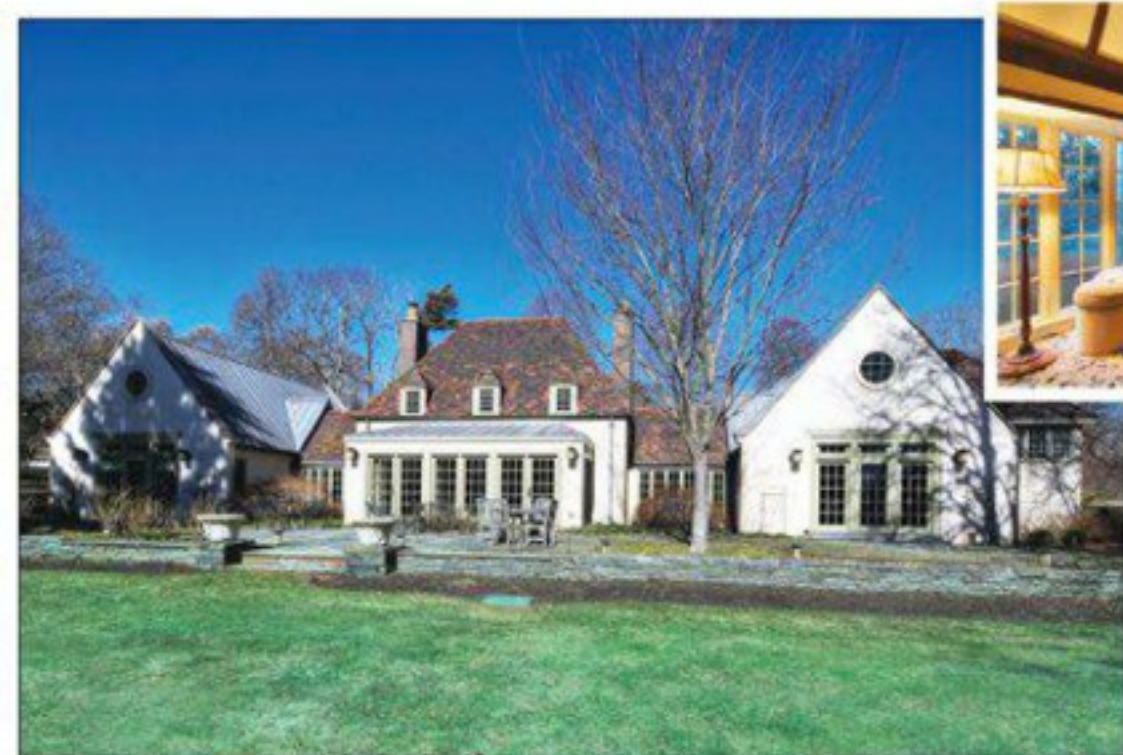




## This week: Homes for retirement



**1 ◀ Marana, Ariz.** This two-bedroom, single-story house is outside of downtown Tucson in a Ritz-Carlton Residences community. The interior features an open floor plan, a great room with retractable glass walls, and custom woodwork. **2 ◀ Middletown, R.I.** Built in 1926 by Harrie T. Lindeberg on a 6.1-acre lot, this home once was a kennel that held up to 40 dogs.
