1 **◀ Tucson** Built in 1981, this four-bedroom house sits on 0.7 acres of desert. The home includes French doors, a media room with a kitchenette, and a master suite with heated bathroom floors. 2 **◀ Marana, Ariz.** Sitting on 0.3 acres, this two-bedroom home is part of a private Ritz-Carlton community at Dove Mountain. The interior features tongue-and-groove ceilings, travertine floors, and a great room with retractable glass walls. Set along a Jack Nicklaus golf course, the house allows for views of the Tortolita and Santa Catalina mountains. \$1,379,000. 3 **▶ St. George, Utah** This five-bedroom house lies on 2.5 acres in Entrada, a private golf community.
